

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

Volksmarches (people walks) are non-competitive public walking events whose purpose is to encourage physical fitness and enjoy the out-of-doors. Since this is not a contest of speed or endurance, each person should walk, run or jog at a pace that is comfortable and enjoyable.

**WHO MAY PARTICIPATE:**

Everyone regardless of age or level of fitness is invited to participate.

**REGISTRATION & START CARDS:**

All participants, including infants and children must check in at the registration table and receive a START CARD.

Your START CARD must be signed before starting the walk and must be returned to the finish table upon completion of the walk. This procedure allows us to keep track of participants.

**REFRESHMENTS:**

Water will be provided for you and your pets at the start/finish area and checkpoints.

**CONDITIONS:**

The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

**PETS** must be on a leash and under control. Pets may be prohibited from entering some buildings.

**DISCLAIMER:** The sponsors of this event are not liable for accidents, thefts or material damage. Every reasonable effort will be made to make the walk safe, enjoyable and memorable. All participants are cautioned to take due care and restrain pets and children. By registering for this event, participant agrees to these conditions.

**Note:** *For those unable to make the start deadline, if you arrive before we close up shop, we will issue a start card and you may participate as if this is a YRE.*

**FEES:** This event is FREE to persons who wish to participate without receipt of the award or IVV credits.  
**IVV CREDIT:** \$3.00. There will be NO REFUNDS.  
**IVV CREDITS:** IVV Credits may only be entered into IVV Event or Distance Books. Books will be available for purchase on the day of event at \$5.00 each.

**AWARD:** This is a "credit only" walk.

**TRAIL DESCRIPTION AND RATING:**

Trail will wander through Winchester, visiting their parks and points of interest. Trail will be difficult for wheelchairs in some places with uneven sidewalks. Walk with caution in high traffic areas.

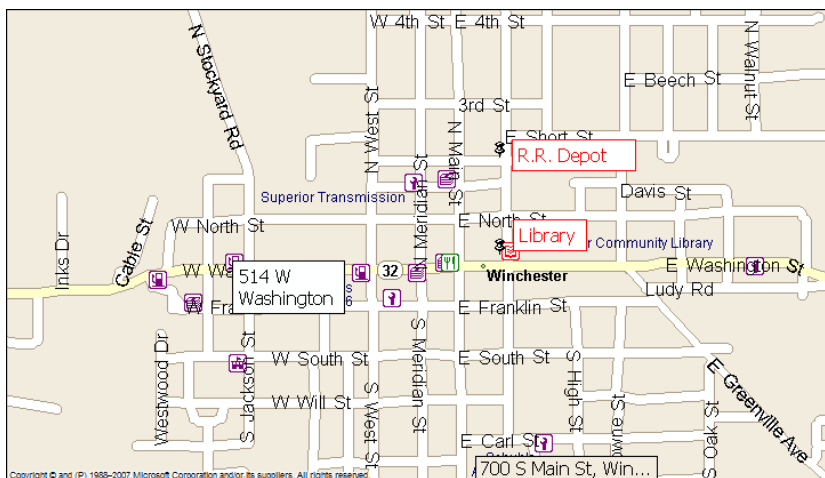
**DIRECTIONS:**

From Indianapolis or Ft. Wayne, take I-69 to SR 32 East. SR 32 East to Winchester. (Ft. Wayne could also take SR 3 to SR 32 East.)

The St. Joseph Church, 514 West Washington St. (SR32) is on the west side of Winchester.

Ft. Wayne can also take SR 27 South to SR32 and turn Right (West) thru Winchester to 514 West Washington St. (SR32).

Richmond and Ohio. Take US27 North to Winchester. Take SR32 West thru Winchester to 514 West Washington St. (SR32).

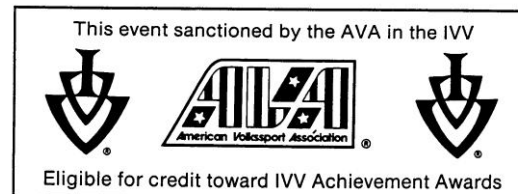
